So, Bible warns to have self-control and not be drunk.


Today's wines and alcoholic drinks are stronger and more dangerous and should be fully avoided.

- •Dung it a = Nourishment / difficult or humbling experiences (Fertilizer = truth, discipline, mercy—even when uncomfortable)
